Gobi, Smola, Berthiaume Announce STEM Grant, Partnership at Pathfinder

(BOSTON) – Senator Anne M. Gobi (D-Spencer), Representative Todd M. Smola (R-Warren), and Representative Donald R. Berthiaume, Jr. (R-Spencer) have announced that Pathfinder Regional Vocational Technical High School, in partnership with Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High School and Quinsigamond Community College, has received a Massachusetts Mathematics and Science Partnership Program (MMSP) grant.

"It is critical that we support STEM programs in any way that we can," said Senator Gobi. "This partnership is great news for students and teachers. Equipping students with dynamic skill sets will help them adapt to constantly evolving industries as they enter the workforce."

Funded programs will be eligible for one additional year of funding based on progress toward meeting their established goals and objectives, subject to the availability of federal funding.
