Legislators Announce CPSS Grant for Quaboag Public Schools

BOSTON – Representative Todd M. Smola (R-Warren), Representative Donald R. Berthiaume, Jr. (R-Spencer) and Senator Anne M. Gobi (D-Spencer) and are pleased to announce that the Quaboag Regional School District has been awarded funding through the Academic Support Collaborative Partnerships for Student Success (CPSS) Grant. Quaboag will receive \$17,100 for fiscal year 2015-2016. This state-funded competitive grant program is designed to help students transition into the early high school years. CPSS resources can be used in a variety of ways but a majority of funds must be used to extend student learning time.
